## **MAKING A SCHOLARSHIP REQUEST**

Each Spring, the AJX Foundation awards scholarships to local DFW area high school seniors providing scholarships and mentorship to well adjusted high school seniors who lack the financial means to pursue Higher Education.

The awarded scholarship is \$10,000 disbursed over four years (\$1250.00 per semester), provided the recipient conforms to the requirements set forth by the AJX Foundation Education Committee. The recipient may select any major at any four year college or university.

Scholarship applications may be submitted during the student's senior year in high school. If writing to the Foundation, the student must identify their high school, month and year of graduation, and include their name and home address. Address all correspondence as follows:

**A number of finalists will be selected from the applications received and will be invited in for a personal interview. Finalists will subsequently be notified in writing if they will or will not receive the AJX Foundation Scholarship. If a student is not invited in for a personal interview by April 1<sup>st</sup>, they should assume that they are not a finalist and no correspondence will be forthcoming from the Foundation.**

## **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

1. High School Seniors after the start of their senior year.
2. DFW area high school seniors who attend schools or are homeschooled in the following eight counties: Collin, Dallas, Denton, Ellis, Hunt, Kaufman, Parker and Tarrant Counties.
3. Students who are citizens of the United States. Students with Permanent Resident status are not eligible.
4. The Scholarships are awarded based on "financial need" and "scholastic ability."

## INSTRUCTIONS

Instructions must be followed accurately to make certain that your application is considered. Applicants are welcomed and encouraged to contact the AJX Foundation, should there be any questions on how to follow these instructions. 1. Complete the online SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION.
2. Complete each line or question on all forms. Anything left blank will result in the application not being considered. Also, "N/A" is not an acceptable answer. "None" or "Zero" may be used where appropriate.
3. Do not submit an application before you take the SAT or ACT. To apply for a scholarship, you must have a minimum SAT score of 900 (on the Math and Critical Reading portions combined), and/or ACT score of 19. The new writing section of the SAT will be considered, but not in figuring the SAT minimum.
4. Upload and submit all items shown at the bottom of the Scholarship prior to submitting the application. If an item is received by itself, it is discarded. Incomplete applications are not considered.
5. Note that if you or your parents filed your income tax return electronically, the detailed paper copies uploaded must be signed.
6. Only applications submitted online are accepted and reviewed by the AJX Foundation.
7. **All applications must be submitted on or before March 22<sup>st</sup>. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
